In the event that you would like to send an article and/or a review, please observe the following guidelines:

- Include with the article your first and last name, e-mail, and affiliation.
- Articles may be written in Italian, English, French, or German.
- Please included a brief summary of the article to be translated into Italian (if the article is in English, French or German) or in English (if the article is in Italian, French or German).
- Articles submitted will be evaluated by our editorial board.
- Articles should be send as Microsoft Word documents (or in a compatible format, such as RTF). In the event that the article contains tables, photos, images, etc., please send a copy in PDF format as well. Photos should also be sent separately in JPG or TFF format. If special fonts are also required, please attach them to the document.
